FOREWORD

I felt the need for a directory compiling basic information on South Asian institutions working in the field of international relations when, as a research scholar based at the *Centre de Sciences Humaines* (CSH) - a French research institution located in New Delhi -, I had to identify these institutes and academic centres during my stay in India and my visits to the neighbouring countries.

My aim was to have a list of institutions as comprehensive as possible. Since international relations covers a wide range of topics, it was considered useful to include not only the traditional fields of international politics and strategic issues, but also some remarkable institutes working primarily on economics. Relevant centres of excellence, for which international relations is only one field of research among others, do also find a place in this directory. Being institution-wise, only publications published by the institution itself, or in collaboration with a publishing house, are mentioned in this directory. Originally, it was also my intention to provide more detailed information on the faculty members and research scholars whose names are hereinafter included. It turned out to be a too tough proposition for a first edition.

I would like to thank, first of all, Uma Krishnan, Publications in-charge at the *Centre de Sciences Humaines*, for her logistical support after my return to Paris and her patience in sending numerous reminders to defaulting institutions (for those which have nevertheless not replied, only minimal information in our possession are given on a country-basis). My thanks go also to Dr. Bruno Dorin and Dr. Pierre Audinet, successive directors of the CSH, for making this publication possible. Lastly, many thanks to the Heads of institutions for their co-operation in answering our questionnaire.

This directory has taken a long time to compile and in spite of a regular updating, there might be some minor differences between the information I collected from the returned questionnaires and the exact position in the institutions at the time of publication (for instance, in case of rotating chairmanship, the Director or the Head of department may have changed).

This directory is meant to be regularly updated, therefore we would greatly appreciate if the institutions could help us in this regard, by eventually completing the information appearing in the following pages. The contact address is :
